 The station was completed in 1896 and lit the following year.
It is still operating today!

 The steam whistle was typically in operation for about 225 hours per year and consumed seven tons of coal.

 It's name is derived from the fact that the light sits 40 miles southeast of Old Mackinac Point.

 The Great Lakes Lore Maritime Museum, in Rogers City, focuses on marine personnel.

 The Frensel lens is one of only 70 still in operation in the U.S., 16 of which are on the Great Lakes.

 The grounds contain many of the original structures such as the keeper's house, bunkhouse, foghorn building, and oil house.
