 The lighthouse was built and first lit in 1869 and is still in operation today.

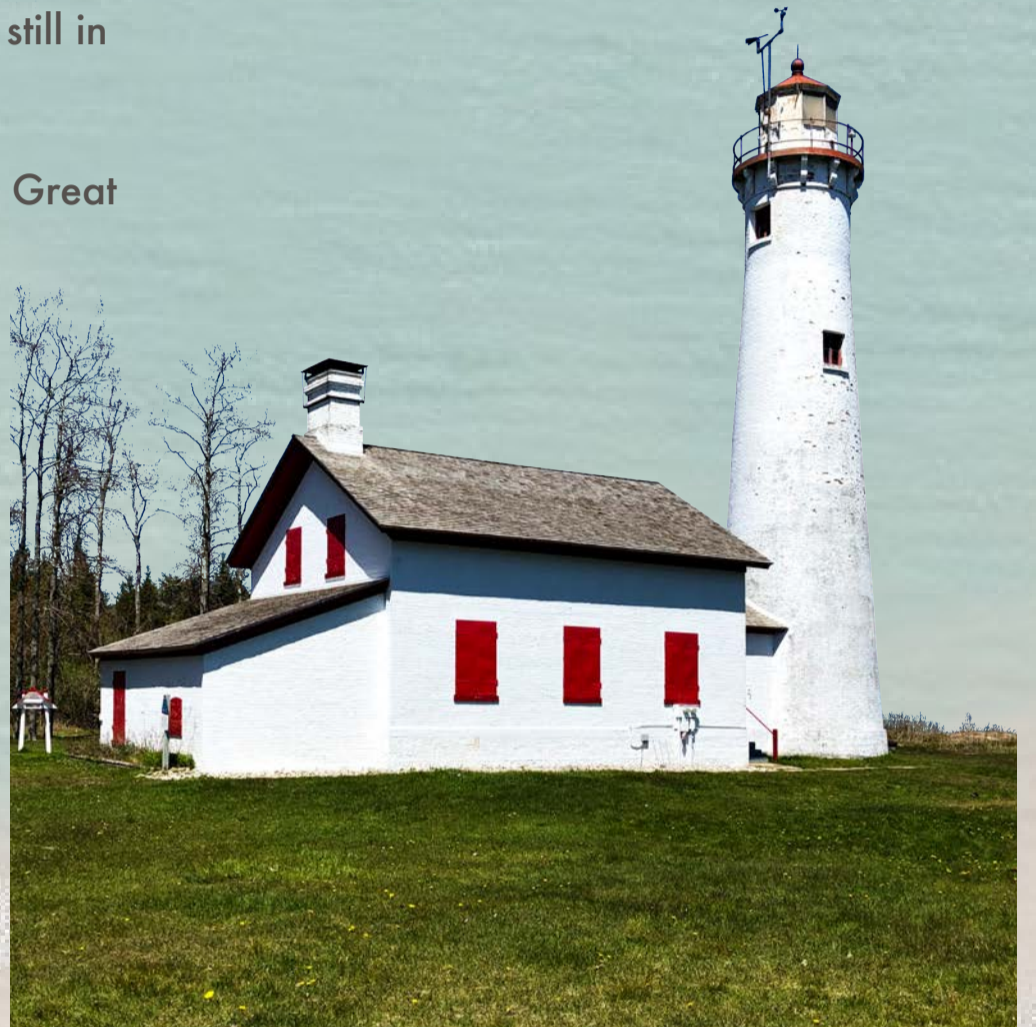
 The light is a historic example of a Cape Cod style Great Lakes lighthouse.

 The lifesaving bell was stolen in 1951 and was anonymously returned to the Alcona County Historical Society in 2002.

 Harrisville is the sixth-smallest city by population in the state of Michigan.

 Located on Lake Huron, the city is a Michigan DNR Harbor of Refuge.

 The region marks the southernmost extent of the Thunder Bay National Marine Sanctuary.
