Fun Facts!

-  The lighthouse was constructed and lit in 1853. A new tower was completed in 1877 and is still active.
-  There is a replica of the light in William G. Milliken State Park and Harbor in Detroit.
-  The first keeper of the lighthouse had an annual salary of \$350.
-  Tawas Point State Park has been called the Cape Cod of the Midwest and is a noted bird-watching site.
-  The lighthouse serves as the only representative of a victorian-era style station on the Great Lakes.
-  When the bay freezes the area becomes known as Perchville USA and is the largest non-land community festival in NE Michigan.
