### Fun Facts!


 Located on Port Austin Reef about 2.5 miles from Port Austin, at the southernly side of the entrance to Saginaw Bay.

 Port Austin Light is still an operational aid to navigation and the County's only offshore lighthouse.

 In 1953 the lighthouse was fully automated and the last keepers departed.

 Port Austin is home to the rock formation Turnip Rock found northeast of town.

 The nearby Port Crescent State Park is said to have one of the finest sand beaches in the state of Michigan.

 A destination since the late 19th century, the Grindstone General Store is the last existing business from the original Grindstone City.
