Fun Facts!

The original lighthouse was established in 1839 on the Grand Haven beach.

The current towers were first lit in 1905 and remains operational today.

The Fresnel lens used in the 1855 tower can still be seen in the Tri-Cities Historical Museum's Train Depot.

Grand Haven is the official Coast Guard City, USA.

The annual Coast Guard Festival brings 300,000 visitors and is one of the largest festivals in the state.

There are over 100 miles of bike paths in the area to explore.
