Fun Facts!

-  The original lighthouse was established in 1839 on the Grand Haven beach.
-  The current towers were first lit in 1905 and remains operational today.
-  The Fresnel lens used in the 1855 tower can still be seen in the Tri-Cities Historical Museum's Train Depot.
-  Grand Haven is the official Coast Guard City, USA.
-  The annual Coast Guard Festival brings 300,000 visitors and is one of the largest festivals in the state.
-  There are over 100 miles of bike paths in the area to explore.
