Big Sable was the last Great Lakes lighthouse to get electricity in 1949.



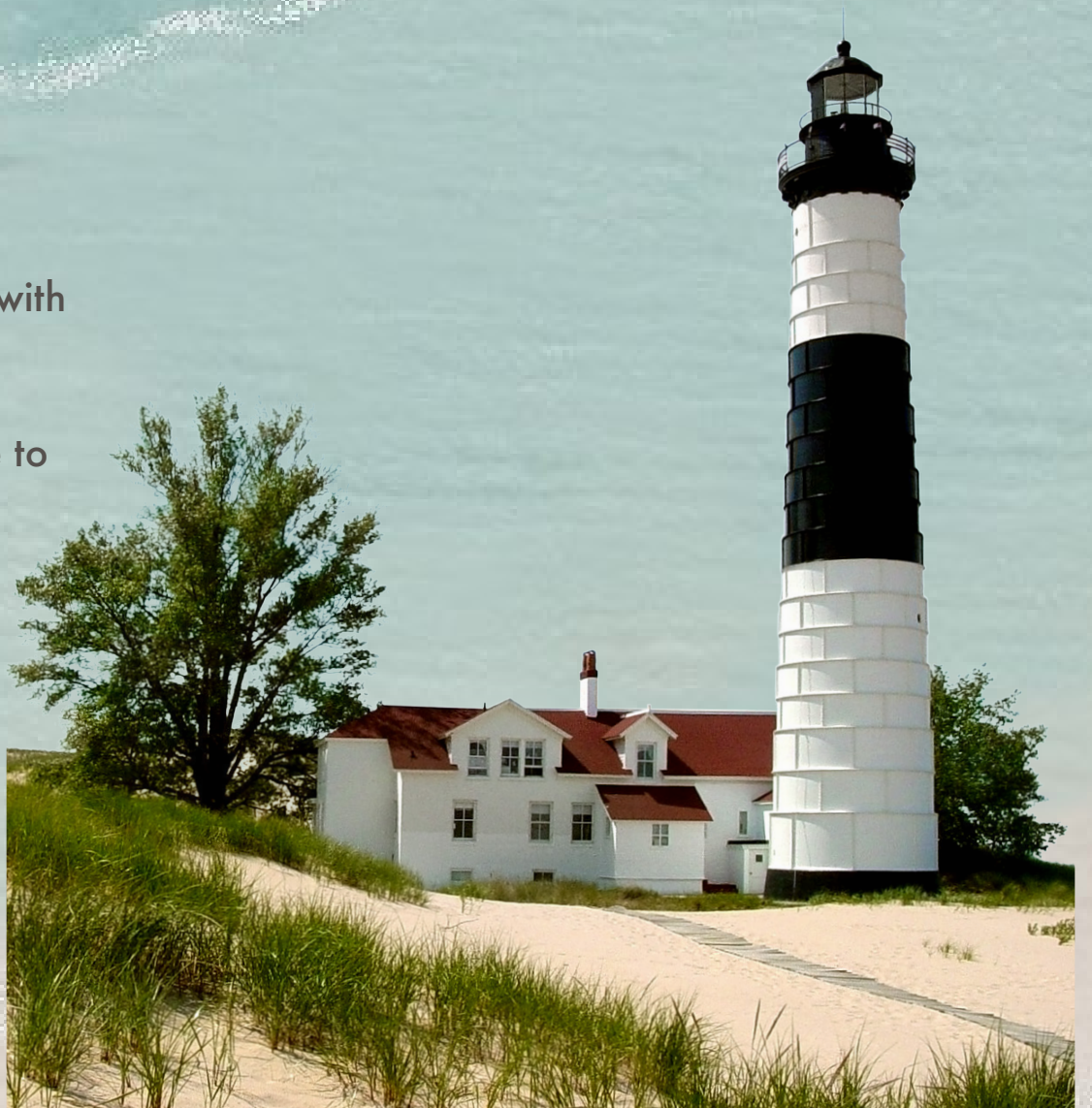
Ludington, with its many parks and festivals, is fifth most popular tourist city in Michigan.
