 The current light was built in 1858, replacing a separate structure built in 1852.

 You can visit the museum for tour of a 1920-1930s style keeper's home along with exhibits on local lighthouse history.

 You can work and stay in the light for one week through their Keeper Program.

 Nearby Sleeping Bear Dunes is considered one of the most beautiful places in America.

 Leelanau County boasts 26 wineries and produces some of Michigan's best.

 The county has the second highest proportion of water area of any county in the U.S.
