## *Fun Facts!*

-  The current light was built and first lit in 1870 at the end of Old Mission Point.
-  The design is an exact copy of the Mama Juda Light built on the Detroit River.
-  The lighthouse is a few hundred yards south of the 45th parallel north, placing it halfway between the Equator and North Pole.
-  The Traverse City area is the one of largest producer of cherries in the U.S.
-  The annual National Cherry Festival brings 500,000 visitors to the city.
-  The city is consistently voted a top small town travel destination in the country.
