Fun Facts!


- Originally constructed as a fog signal in 1889, the lighthouse was built in 1892.
- The light station closed following the construction of the Mackinaw Bridge in 1957.
- It's light was visibale for an impressive 14 nautical miles.
- Mackinaw City has consistently been rated the top tourist city in the state of Michigan.
- Popular attractions include Fort
 Michilimackinac, the Mackinac Bridge, and
 the USCG Icebreaker Mackinaw.
- Historic Mackinac Island is just a short boat ride away, and is perfect for a day trip.
